

Implications for PMP® and CAPM®

- It is important to note that the PMP® exam is based on the Exam Content Outline, not on the *PMBOK® Guide*. The Exam Content Outline summarizes the research conducted to create the PMP® exam and includes the most critical tasks required for project managers to master in their role. The current Exam Content Outline, dated January 2021, was designed to stay relevant for the foreseeable future, and PMI will give advance notice to the public before a new ECO and corresponding exam is launched.
- The *PMBOK*® *Guide* is one of numerous potential inputs to preparing for the exam—and is listed as a reference—but it is not a test-preparation tool. The PMP exam is created based on the Exam Content Outline and uses many sources for question development.
